Anderson Room

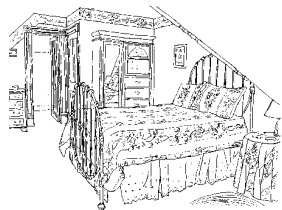
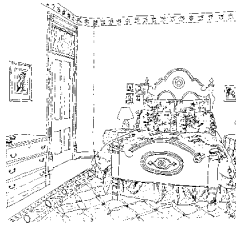

McKie Room

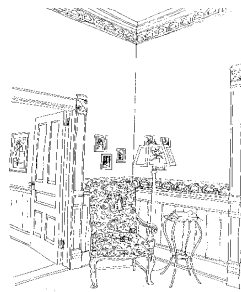
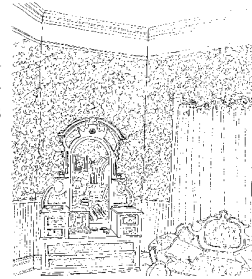

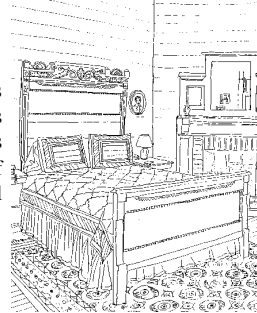


Willingham Room

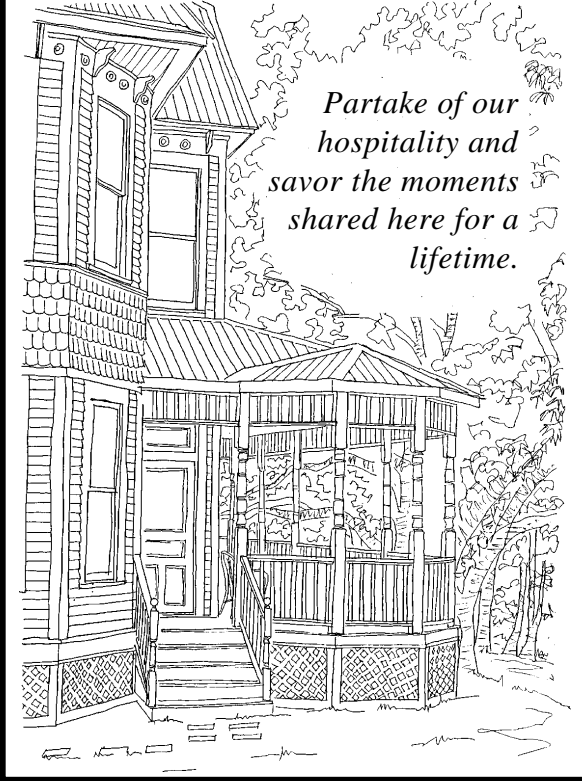
The Giles - Kindred House

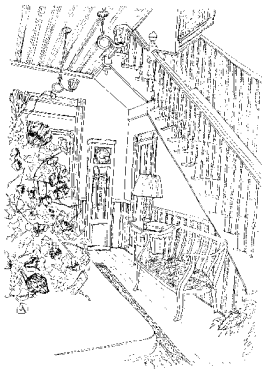

This is a place to take a step back in time and experience a lifestyle ob a bygone era.



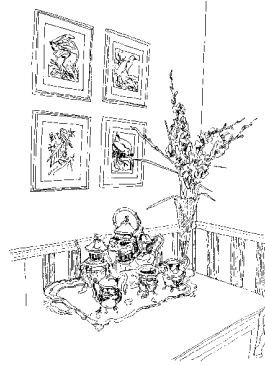

from meal to meal, but will include appetizer, soup or salado, entree with vegetables and dessert.

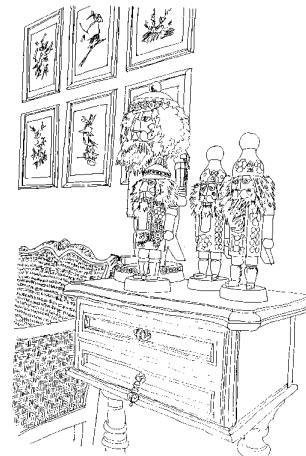

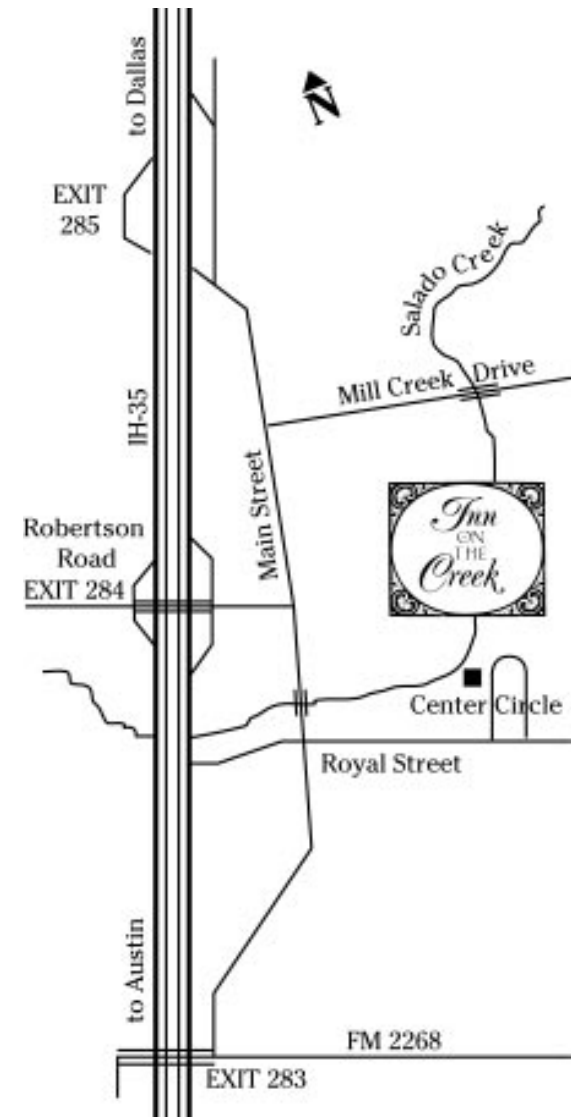


Check-in is after 3 P.M. and check-out is 11 A.M. Reservations are recommended to ensure the room you prefer. **A one night's room rate is required for your deposit when you make your reservations. Major credit cards are accepted. A 72 hour cancellation notice is**



needed. In the event you must cancel in less than 72 hours, your deposit is non-refundable. If we are able to fill your cancelled room, your deposit will be refunded less a \$10 fee. No-shows will charged full room rate. A block of rooms requires a longer cancellation period. Reservations can be booked between the hours of 8 A.M. and 9 P.M. daily by phoning toll free 877-947-5554.

For your safety and consideration of others, we ask that there be no smoking inside the building. Smoking is permitted on the porches and grounds only. Sorry, no pets are allowed. Small children are welcomed in our cottage or Giles - Kindred House only and must be supervised at all times.



Suggestions to ease your way here

Salado is approximately forty-five miles north of Austin on Interstate 35. To get to our Inn from the north, take the Robertson Road exit from 35. Head east to Main Street. Take a right on main and after approximately three blocks (and just after crossing the bridge), left on Royal. After three blocks turn left on Center Circle. The Inn is ahead on the left approximately 200 yards. From the south, take exit 283 and head north on Main Street, turn right on Royal and proceed from there.
